RELEASE OF THE BAR EXAMINATION RESULTS, 2024

Council of Legal Education (CLE) is pleased to release the Advocates Training Programme Examination (Bar Examination) results for the November 2024 series.

Earlier in the year, CLE commenced reforms of the examination processes that aimed at enhancing the integrity, transparency, and credibility of the examination processes. Notable reforms have been implemented. CLE will now be releasing examination results within one and a half months after the examinations, down from three (3) months. Further, Candidates will now be able to access their examination results with a detailed breakdown of scores per question for each ATP Unit, to enhance transparency and accountability. CLE will also no longer publish candidate's results on its website to safeguard candidates' confidentiality and personal information. We are excited about these changes and are working on continuously improving our processes.

In the November 2024 series, 1,475 regular candidates sat for the examination while 1,452 candidates registered to re-sit various unit(s). Remarkably, 716 regular candidates passed all the papers obtaining 9 Ps. Candidates significantly improved ATP 107: Conveyancing and ATP 108: Commercial Transactions. ATP 104: Trial Advocacy ranked highest as compared to the other units which recorded a pass rate of 98.90% for regular candidates and 73.68% for candidates retaking the unit. ATP 105: Professional Ethics performance declined, with a pass rate of 64.36% for regular candidates and 4.67% for candidates retaking the unit.

We congratulate all the candidates for their hard work and dedication during the recently concluded examination. CLE continues to work to transform legal education and training in Kenya, which is in line with its vision of ensuring we have *“Innovative legal professionals transforming society.”*

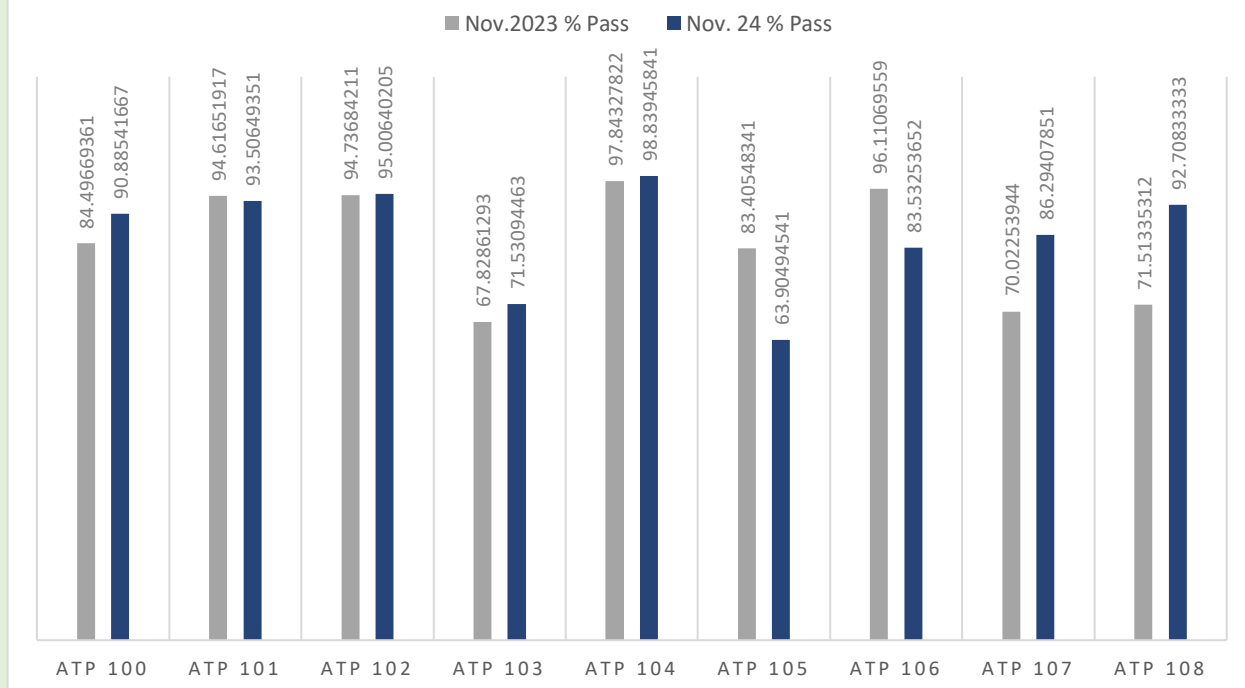

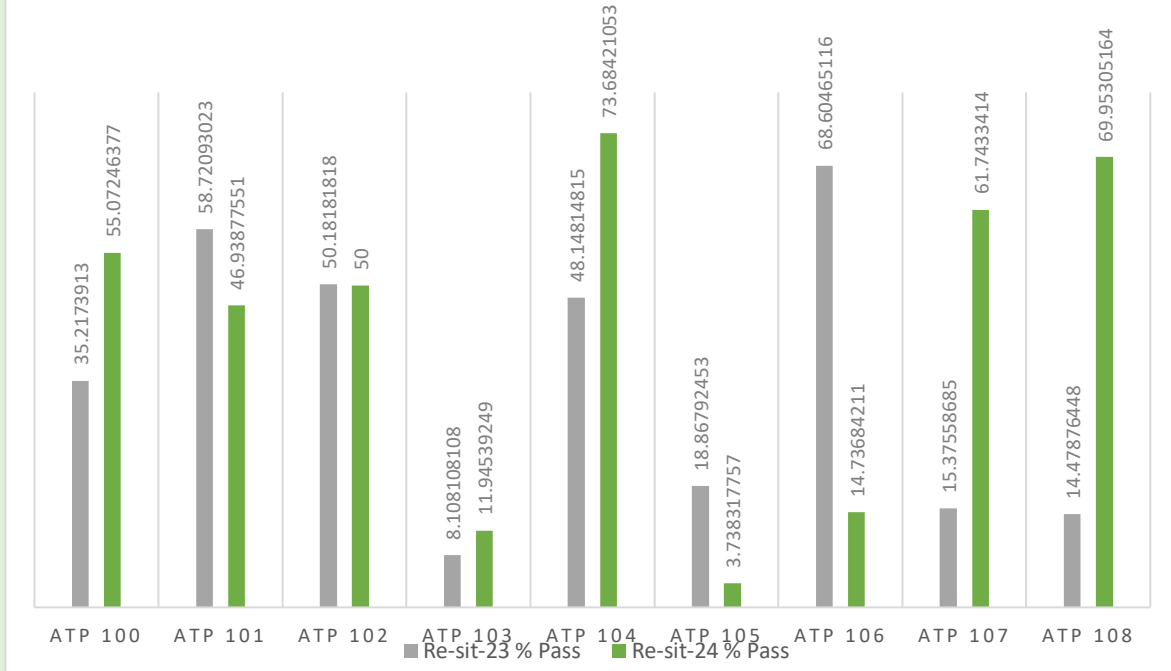
COMPARISON BY PASS RATE- REGULAR
