GENERAL NOTICE NO. 16 OF 2021

ADVOCATES TRAINING PROGRAMME (ATP) CANDIDATES BARRED BY THE FIVE (5) YEAR QUALIFICATION PERIOD

Reference is made to General Notice No. 2 of 2021 dated 3rd February 2021 which invited prospective candidates who were caught up by Regulation 9 (5) of the Council of Legal Education (Kenya School of Law Regulations, 2009) to make requests to Council to sit the ATP Examination out of time.

Council has resolved to allow all candidates who applied to sit the examination out of time following the aforementioned Notice, to sit the ATP Examination and complete the programme within one (1) year, that is, the November 2021 and the June 2022 examination series'.

For the avoidance of doubt, the one (1) year time shall start running from the date of opening of registration for the November 2021 Examination Series.

Dates for registration for the two (2) ATP examination series will be communicated in due course through Council's website and notice boards.
