IT IS NOTIFIED for general information that registration for the October 2022 Council of Legal Education ATP Examination will commence on 8th July 2022 and close on 31st August 2022

Candidates will be required to register Online through the Council candidate's portal http://exam.cle.or.ke:882/

The requisite Examination fees are as indicated in the Students Guide that can be viewed or downloaded from Council's official website. Examination fee is payable through Mpesa Paybill No 4060345. A candidate should only make payments after logging in to the portal and providing all requisite information and attachments where applicable.

NB: A Regular candidate applying for registration of the ATP examination must have completed the Oral and Project examination.



Appendix I: Procedure for registration of candidates who have used the CLE portal previously

Login to the candidate's portal via http://exam.cle.or.ke:882/ and click on registration as shown below.



You will see your registration summary over the series as shown below



To register or add units, click on the red button.

The next window will be of the selection of units and payment for the units.


The system will list for you the units that you have not passed in their respective categories whether first time (sitting for the first time) and resit (failed units).

If a unit is deferred, the column for deferred will be yes.




To register a unit, tick the check box on the unit row. You will see subsequent change in the billable amount.

After selection of the units, the system will compute for you the amount to be paid. Please note that the only available payment platform is via MPESA.




Click on Pay Now to make the payment. A popup window will appear. Confirm your phone number and click on trigger MPESA Express. A prompt will be sent to your phone for PIN Entry and deduction of funds from MPESA. Ensure you have sufficient funds.



Use the Registration Number as the Account Number

After payment, the available funds will be credited with the equivalent of the paid amounts. Select the examination region of choice and then complete registration.




You will then be redirected to the registered units summary and will be able to see the series registered units.

Appendix II: Procedure for registration for a candidate registering for the ATP examination for the first time

Login to the candidate's portal and click as shown below to continue with registration process.



Please note that the following documents must be uploaded on the portal during the application process:

- a) A clear digital passport size photo (soft copy)
- b) Scanned original documents of: (strictly in PDF format)
 - i) Kenya School of Law Admission letter (all pages)
 - ii) LL.B University certificate
 - iii) LL.B University transcripts (all four years scanned in one document)
 - iv) High School certificate
 - v) National Identification card/passport (both sides scanned in one document)

Where applicable;

- Letter of equation from Kenya National Qualification Authority
- Pre-Bar Certificate (Kenya School of Law)
- Clearance by Council of Legal Education

Fill in the BIO-DATA FORM - Form No. CLE/EX.05 and send a scanned copy to Council via email examinations@cle.or.ke. The form must be completely filled.
