## GENERAL NOTICE NO. 16 OF 2023 REGISTRATION FOR NOVEMBER 2023 ADVOCATES TRAINING PROGRAMME (ATP) EXAMINATION

IT IS NOTIFIED for general information that registration for the November 2023 Council of Legal Education ATP Examination will commence on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> August 2023 and close on Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2023.

Candidates should register within the specified period above to avoid non-compliance.

Candidates will be required to register by <u>logging in http://exam.cle.or.ke:882/</u> to access the CLE online registration portal.

The requisite Examination fees are provided in the Students Guide which can be accessed or downloaded from the CLE's website. A candidate should ensure that they have enough money in their M-PESA and all the required attachments where applicable before logging into the portal.

Application for HELB for purposes of the November 2023 ATP examination will be closed on 6<sup>th</sup> September 2023.


A list of registered candidates will be published on the Council website before the examination.

Please note that the following documents must be uploaded on the portal during the application process:

- a) A clear digital passport-size photo (soft copy)
- b) Scanned original documents of: (strictly in PDF format)
  - i) Kenya School of Law Admission letter (all pages)
  - ii) LL.B University certificate
  - iii) LL.B University transcripts (all four years scanned in one document)
  - iv) High School certificate
  - v) National Identification card/passport (both sides scanned in one document)







After selection of the units, the system will compute for you the amount to be paid. Please note that the only available payment platform is via MPESA.


